

RESOLUTION NO. 2016-022

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE NORTH GROUNDS OF THE ALBANY COUNTY COURTHOUSE NEAR IVINSON STREET TO BE NAMED THE ROB DEBREE PARK.

WHEREAS, Rob DeBree served thirty-four (34) years as a peace officer, 31 of which was service with the Albany County Sheriff's Office.

WHEREAS, Rob DeBree served as a deputy, detective sergeant, lieutenant, and detective lieutenant, prior to becoming Undersheriff for the Albany County Sheriff's Office.

WHEREAS, Rob DeBree was recognized nationally for his work investigating the 1998 murder of University of Wyoming student, Matthew Shepard. That year, he was named the American Legion Lawman of the Year, and he would receive the Human Rights Campaign Equality Award, four years later.

WHEREAS, Rob's dedication to family and those he worked with is recognized by all.

WHEREAS, Albany County recognizes Rob DeBree's commitment to law enforcement, and his service to the citizens of Albany County


NOW THEREFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ALBANY COUNTY, WYOMING, RESOLVES:


